| 16. 'Akishino Temari' | Translated as a large silk cord ball, this is a precious Japanese selection with full heads of very soft pink flowers, probably as close to a "mophead" as the Japanese, in their subtle aesthetic, have come. Stems to 4 ft., in partial shade or full sun with adequate water in summer. | One gal. |
| 17. Amagi Amacha | (Translation: Amagi sweet tea.) This Japanese selection has extremely narrow foliage along stems to 3 ft., and the loveliest of diminutive white lacecaps nestled within. Though a hardy and durable selection, it appears so delicate that one almost wants to whisper in its presence. | One gal. |
| 18. 'Iyo Shibori' | A simple and elegant lacecap with pink fertile flowers surrounded by sterile floret of pink, marbled with deeper shades as well as white, and handsome, narrow foliage with a very long acuminate tip. A charming, delicate demeanor with a tough-as-nails personality. | One gal. |
| 19. 'Iyono-usuzum' | A new and rarely offered selection from Japan known for its inky black flowers (certainly "intensified" in photographs in Japanese horticultural publications). The heads of flowers of this selection are relatively small though for those with further breeding in mind, this new departure in flower color will offer plenty of inspiration. | One gal. |
| 20. 'Komachi' | A new introduction for us last year and we are pleased! One of the few Japanese selections possessing all double floret in a mophead format, with an overall effect of very full, irregularly shaped heads of blue on rather compact stems to less than 4 ft. | One gal. |
| 21. 'Midoriboshi Temari' | Elegant and long, bright pink pedicels carry fully double sterile floret in fading shades of blue to lavender to pink surrounding heads of pink fertile floret for a long period in summer; extremely popular with numerous visitors to the garden. More upright than other selections of this species, ultimately to 5 ft. | One gal. |
| 22. 'Miranda' | A distinctive lacecap with light blue sterile floret, variegated with streaks and stripes of white and lighter colors, surrounding a cluster of fertile blue floret. This has been placed at the entrance to our woodland where it has enchanted every visitor who came upon it this summer. A choice and elegant selection. 3.5 ft. | One gal. |
| 23. 'Shichidanka' | (Translation: Seven-levels flower.) A lovely, demure, double-flowered form of H. serrata, to 3.5 ft., with narrow, jagged-edged leaves and corymbs of flowers surrounded by fully double floret of deep lavender. The foliage takes on orange tints in autumn. | One gal. |
| 24. 'Shirofugi' | (Translation: White-capped Mt. Fuji.) An elegant selection of pure white, star-like fully double sterile floret surrounding small heads of white fertile floret. It comes closer to that which embodies pristine and precious than any plant that I cultivate. Partial shade, in any well-drained soil. Fertile floret may change color in very acidic | One gal. |
